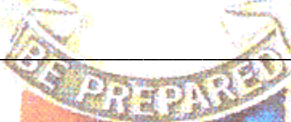

HISTORY

Troop 77 was chartered in 1946. Since then, Troop 77 has produced 73 Eagle Scouts. The Troop has contributed diligently to the community through service to others and an effective, character-building program for boys.

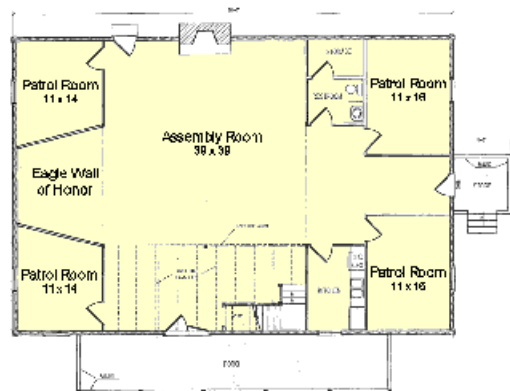

NEW BUILDING

The Troop & Crew Committees feel that new, attractive facilities are necessary for our Scout program in the 21st Century. The current facilities are in poor condition, with no opportunity to improve the building since the property is not owned by the Troop's Sponsor, the Toccoa First United Methodist Church.

Property has been donated to the Troop which is located near the current meeting place. We plan a log structure with a metal roof which will have multiple classrooms and a central meeting room. Kitchen and Rest Room will allow hosting of special events.

The interior will have exposed timber trusses, a fireplace, and an "Eagle Wall of Honor" where we will place a photograph of each of our Eagle Scouts.



NEED

This goal of this fund raising campaign is \$94,000. All construction will be on hold until the cost is funded.

Volunteer labor will be used wherever available for landscape, electrical, plumbing, heating, security, internal framing, etc. The financial need is for materials and special equipment rental. Scouts will assist in construction consistent with their skills.
